## NEW IMPLEMENTATION IN SPS 2014

As part of our efforts to develop a community-based paintball tournament, it is important for the SPS to continue improving in all aspects of tournament management. Through the various feedback channels from the local community, we will always review our existing processes and explore ways to improve them. The following changes will be implemented in 2014:

- a) Teams finishing in the podium (1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> ranked teams) in their respective categories will have their registration spot secured and reserved for the following event until 1 week before closing deadline of Early Bird Registration. This is to provide assistance to the podium finishers so that they do not miss the participation in the following event due to overwhelming registration and miss out on the prestigious Overall Champion title in their respective categories. However, teams are still advised to register with payment early to avoid disappointment.
- b) Teams should be aware about the possible changes to the SPS rules and regulations which are generally adopted from PALS. We will update all participating teams as soon as we have more information from our affiliated partners, PALS and APBBF.
- c) With the adoption of the APPA registration system in 2013, SPS reserves the right to determine a player's status in accordance to the player's experience and participation in local and overseas events. Teams which are unsure about your players' eligibility can email to SPS for verification and confirmation. SPS reserves the right to reject any player's participation if he/she is not rightfully registered into their respective playing level. This paragraph is added into the section under Eligibility.
- d) There will be no change to the marker importation and exportation process for Singapore-based players whose paintball markers are kept in Malaysia. However, do note that as there may be new implementations to the current possession regulations in Malaysia in the later part of the year and with the current uncertainties, players who are applying for paintball marker importation and exportation will now have to sign a Release of Liability with SPS. Players are advised to check with Malaysia field operators on the current regulations for marker importation and exportation in Malaysia and at Malaysia's immigrations and customs. As per past events, SPS will assist to apply for import and export permit in Singapore and at Singapore's immigrations and customs.
- e) SPS reserves the right to reject the use of non-registered paintball markers. All paintball markers used during the SPS are lawfully registered and approved by the Singapore Police Force. SPS will take necessary enforcement actions against errant players or teams which violate this regulation.

## TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

**SPS 1on1 Challenge 2014 – 1 June 2014 (Sunday) – Red Dynasty Paintball Park @ The Cage Sports Park, Bukit Timah (Former Turf City).**

**SPS 1on1 Challenge 2014 is organized as a one-day event and eligible for participant to only Singapore citizens, Permanent residents, work permit holders, student-pass holders.**

Time: 8.30 am (Registration), 9.00 am (Game commencement) – 6.30 pm (Estimated end time)

### GAME FORMAT

Participant of this event will be required to participate in an electronic marker setup. Participants without an electronic marker will be able to rent an electronic marker from Red Dynasty Paintball Park at \$35.00 per marker. As there are only limited numbers of electronic markers available, please reserve your equipment early with Red Dynasty Paintball Park.

**Game Time: 3 minutes per game**

**Firing Mode: Semi or Ramping PSP/ Millennium, Rate of Fire: Capped at 12.0 bps**

**Load: Unlimited number of pods**

SPS will register a total 64 participants for this event. The conduct of this event will be subjected to the number of participants in group of 32 or 64. If the number of participants falls short of 64 participants, we will conduct the competition for the first 32 registered players. All players who register after the 32<sup>nd</sup> participant will be refunded with registration fee.

Participants will be randomly drawn into fixtures with allocated number commencing from #1 to #64 before the event. Game fixtures will only be posted on event day at 8.30 am. Players will need to be aware of their game schedule with the progression of the game.

Games will be conducted in a double elimination system. To be eliminated from the tournament, participant will need to lose 2 games. This will be the same for the final games where the winner of this event will have to win twice to be crowned as the SPS 1on1 Challenge 2014 Champion. All players will be scheduled to participate in the Winner's Bracket. If a player loses a game in the Winner's Bracket, he/she will be relegated to the Loser's Bracket. Players will be eliminated from the tournament if they conceal another loss in the Loser's Bracket.

Each game will be scheduled for 3 minutes. When a clear winner cannot be determined in a draw game, the following procedure will adopted:

Game time expires - Player who is nearer to the opponent's base will be allocated with the win.

Game time expires with players at the 50s line - Results will be null and void. Another 3 minutes game will be conducted with immediate. Players will not be allowed to gas tank and refill pods.

Players trade off – Results will be null and void. Another 3 minutes game will be conducted with immediate. Players will not be allowed to gas tank and refill pods.



## EQUIPMENT

Participants must be self sufficient in terms of paintball equipment which includes paintball marker, paintball mask, paintball loader and paintball tank. With prior arrangements, players who are SPLAT registered with tagged markers will be able to use their tagged markers during the tournament. Participants without a paintball marker can apply for rental with SPS at \$35.00 per marker during the tournament. Rentals are subjected to availability and allocation will be on a first come first serve basis. All markers used during the event must be formally approved by the SPS. Local paintball field operators who are affiliated with the SPS will be required to submit their list of paintball markers to the SPS prior to the event for registration. All applications for transfers must have proper validation and approval from the SPF through the operators' applications to SPF before the event and approval documents provided upon request.

SPS will not entertain any participant with paintball markers which are not registered with the SPS.

## ELIGIBILITY

All participants MUST be 14 years old and above. Participants who are between 14 –18 years old would require parental consent before participation. **SPS 1on1 Challenge 2014 is organized as a one-day event and eligible for participant to only Singapore citizens, Permanent residents, work permit holders, student-pass holders.**

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

Players will be eliminated in accordance to PALS rules and regulations. SPS will adopt the same set of rules and regulations used in the Paintball Asia League Series (PALS) with minor changes accommodated to the SPS 1on1 Challenge 2014. Participants are reminded to read the rules and regulations of competition paintball before the event. The SPS will be officiated by Singapore Paintball Series Referees and AsiaRefs.

Please note that it is important for all players to understand the rules and regulations of competition paintball before participation. APPA registration points will not be awarded to teams and players for this event.
