


#### ABOUT SINGAPORE PAINTBALL SERIES (SPS)

#### **GAME FORMAT**



Asia 1vs1 Open Championship (1vs1) is a 1-man competition. This division will be run on the SPS Rules & Format (2 minutes) based on elimination and capped at 2 pods per player. This is an electronic division open to all players regardless of nationality, gender, age or division.



Asia Under-23 Championship (U23) is a 3-men division with a maximum roster size of 5 players. It will be based on the SPS Rules & Format (6 minutes) with Mercy Limit 2 and capped at 2 pods per player. This is an electronic division open to all participants up to the age of 23 years old (inclusive) regardless of nationality, gender and division. Participants born on or after 01 Jan 1996 are eligible for this division.



**Singapore 7s Series (7s)** is a 7-men division i.e. 7 players can be fielded at any one time with a maximum roster size of 9 players. It will be based on the SPS Rules & Format (7 minutes) with Mercy Limit 1 and no limit on pods. This is an electronic division open to all players regardless of nationality, age, gender and division.



Asia Paintball Masters (APM) is a 5-men division with a maximum roster size of 8 players. It will be based on the SPS Rules & Format (7 minutes) with Mercy Limit 2 and capped at 4 pods per player. This is an electronic division open to all with age 35 years old and above (inclusive). Participants born on or before 31 Dec 1984 are eligible for this division. There is no maximum age limit. Health check is advisable and physical readiness for participation is necessary for the player's own safety.



Asia Girls Paintball International Championship (AGPIC) is a 5-men division and each team can register up to 8 players. This division shall be run on SPS Rules & Format (7 minutes) with Mercy Limit 2 and capped at 4 pods per player. This is an electronic division open to all female players of any nationality, age or division.

Applicable to all divisions:

- (a) Minimum Age The minimum age to participate in paintball is 14 years old based on Singapore's regulations. This rule supersedes all age eligibility above and applies across all divisions.
- (b) Coaching There will be NO coaching across all divisions.
- (c) Firing Mode Semi or Ramping (PSP/ Millennium/ NXL), Rate of Fire: Capped at 10.5 bps
- (d) SPS Rules & Regulations will apply to the above divisions and can be downloaded from SPS website.

#### **NOTE:**

Participants taking part in the event must be self-sufficient in terms of paintball equipment which includes paintball marker, paintball mask, paintball loader and paintball tank. Local players with personal equipment stored in Malaysia and would like to use them for the SPS must complete a request form in full strictly at least 3-4 weeks prior to the event to have their equipment imported and exported in and out of Singapore before and after the event. An administrative fee of \$35.00/\$45.00 (depending on quantity and date of travel) per paintball marker will be imposed for Singapore teams for such arrangements. There will be no fee incurred for overseas-based teams.

**COMPLETE REGISTRATION** 

Team registration is only completed upon payment of team registration fees and player ID Tags. Don't miss out on the early bird discounts. Complete registration early to secure your slot.

3 BOOK YOUR FLIGHT

Book early for the best flight deals! There is only 1 international airport in Singapore - Changi International Airport. Getting from the airport to the city is easy (eg. taxi, Grab, MRT, bus) and fast (15-40min).

4 BOOK YOUR ACCOMMODATION
Refer to the last page for our suggestions on accommodation in Singapore!

5 SUBMIT YOUR MARKER DETAILS

Paintball markers are classified as firearms in Singapore but don't worry! All you need to do is to submit your marker details at least 4 weeks (no extension) before the event. The Markers Importation Form can be found on our website - www.singaporepaintballseries.com.

6 MARKER DECLARATION UPON ARRIVAL

At Singapore Customs, declare your paintball markers with the pre-issued import license. Once you have passed Singapore customs, a SPS staff will be waiting to receive the markers from you for safekeeping till the event.

**ENJOY SINGAPORE** 

SPS organizes free city walking tours before the event. Like and share our Facebook page to receive all the updates on the competition and activities nearer to the event date. Check with event organizer regarding the specially arranged walking tours for SPS overseas participants.



#### **OVERSEAS PAINTBALL MARKERS**

All transfer arrangements will be made by the SPS. All applications are subjected to approval from the SPS and the Singapore Police Force. Please visit www.singaporepaintballseries.com on details for importation and exportation. You will be expected to provide your confirmed travel itinerary in full and with complete accuracy. The following information is required:

- a) Name of user
- b) Passport number
- c) Nationality
- d) Mode of travel Car, Flight, Ferry
- e) Location of entry Singapore Changi Airport, Woodlands Checkpoint, Tuas Checkpoint, HarbourFront Ferry
- f) Date of arrival and departure (This information will be stated on your import/export permit and has to be accurate based on your travel plans due to verification by the local authorities.)
- g) Marker brand
- h) Marker model
- i) Marker serial number

All markers used during the event must be formally approved by the SPS and Singapore Police Force. Local paintball field operators who are affiliated with the SPS will be required to submit their list of paintball markers to the SPS prior to the event for registration. All applications for transfers must have validation and approval from the SPF through the operators' applications to SPF before the event and approval documents shall be provided upon request.

SPS will not entertain any participant with paintball markers which are not registered and approved in advance with the SPS.

If unsure, please do not bring your paintball markers to Singapore without prior approval as they will be confiscated by the Customs during your entry into Singapore. It is a lawful offence in Singapore to be in possession of a paintball marker without a valid permit.

#### **OVERSEAS PAINTBALL MARKER IMPORTATION FORM** MUST BE SUBMITTED 4 WEEKS BEFORE EVENT DATE.


Overseas teams and players who are committed to participating in the SPS will need to contact the organizers and submit the complete travel itinerary event date for the clearance of their paintball markers. Prior approval must be sought from the Singapore Police Force for teams to bring their personal paintball equipment across the immigration and custom checkpoint. Teams without prior approval from the SPF will be lawfully dealt with under the Singapore Firearms Act. All overseas teams will need to fill up the SPS Marker Import/Export Form. Information submitted will be sent to Singapore Police Force. All applications are subjected to approval from the Singapore Police Force. There will be no additional cost to the importation and exportation of markers into Singapore as this will sponsored by the SPS for travelling overseas teams and players. Teams and players are advised to import the same number

of paintball markers as per their registered team roster with a suggested 2 additional backup markers. E.g. If overseas team registers 10 players in its team and marker details strictly at least 3-4 weeks before roster, they will be eligible to import a total of 12 (10 players + 2 backup) paintball markers for the SPS. We strongly do not recommend for overseas teams to assist Singapore-based players to import/export their markers for the event to allow the SPS to uphold a fair system for Singapore-based participants. Assisting local teams with importation can lead to administrative complications that might arise from accountability issues at the Immigration and Customs Department and the Singapore Police Force.

For this event in July 2019, we will NOT be using the PBLI for registration but we will be using the PBLI as one of the sources for reference checking.

#### **EQUIPMENT**

Players will need to have their personal paintball equipment such as paintball mask, loaders, tanks, barrel socks, pods, harness/pack, etc. SPS will not be responsible for any loss or damage of the equipment during the event.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This event will be regulated using the SPS Rules and This event will be officiated by Singapore Paintball Regulations available on SPS website. #### SUGGESTED HOTELS

The suggested hotels are:

- 1) Pegasus Boutique Hotel is located in Turf City (2 minutes' drive to the paintball field). It is located at the entrance of Turf City and within walking distance to Six Avenue MRT Station. Teams can walk to the paintball field through the family theme mall The Grandstand which has restaurants and a supermarket.
- 2) Oxford Hotel is located in 218 Queen Street, Singapore 188549 (20 minutes drive to paintball field). It is in an excellent location in the city and within walking distance to Bras Basah MRT Station and Bugis MRT Station.
- 3) 85 Beach Garden Hotel is a budget 3-star hotel located at 85 Beach Road, Singapore (20 minutes drive to paintball field). It provides basic accommodation with excellent location in the city and is surrounded by restaurants and cafes (24 hours). It is near Bugis MRT Station.







#### **GETTING AROUND SINGAPORE**

 GrabCar and GoJek are 2 of the more popular apps used by locals for getting around the city. Enter the destination as "Red Dynasty Paintball Park (Turf City, Bukit Timah), Turf Club Road" to get to the field.



2) Use an EZ-Link Card to get around the city by MRT and bus. The EZ-Link Card is sold at any MRT station or bus terminal. Download the mobile app "My Transport Singapore" (released by Land Transport Authority) to help you plan for journeys by bus and MRT. Each train or bus ride costs approximately SGD1-3. The entire city of Singapore is accessible by MRT system. To get from one end of Singapore (East) to the other end of Singapore (West), it will be approximately 45 minutes by car.



3) If you are travelling from Malaysia, you can enter Singapore via the Tuas Checkpoint or the Woodlands Checkpoint. From the checkpoint to the paintball field, it is approximately 25 minutes by car. Red Dynasty Paintball Park is located in central Singapore.



4) If you are travelling by flight, you can flag a taxi or book a Grab/GoJek ride from Changi Airport to the field. The approximate duration of the journey from the airport to the field is about 25 minutes and cost around \$25.
