Dear friends and supporters of Singapore Paintball Series,

Welcome to 2023! This year feels like a fresh start to me with the pandemic seemingly fading into history. I hope I am not jinxing the world with such a statement. The World Health Organization (WHO) declared the outbreak a public health emergency of international concern on 30 January 2020, and a pandemic on 11 March 2020. PAINTBALLS

High quality and reputable brand paintballs will be used for all SPS events. Tournament grade paintballs will be sold on event day at \$75.00 to \$80.00 per box of 2000 paintballs.

PLAYERS ELIGIBILITY

All participants MUST be 14 years old and above. Participants who are between 14 - 17 years old will require parental consent before participation. This tournament is open to all local and overseas players. SPS reserves the right to reject any team and/or player's participation if he/she is not rightfully registered into their respective playing levels. SPS advises all teams to confirm your team roster early to avoid complications with playing status. SPS will not be responsible for any cost incurred by teams or players for ineligibility.

OPEN DIVISION

Players participating in this division should comprise of players who are familiar with the equivalent playing level of Division 1 and Division 2 across the Asia Pacific paintball circuit. New to SPS 2023, a maximum of 2 Pro Players can be rostered in the Open Division teams.

AMATEUR & AGPIC DIVISION

Players participating in this division should comprise of players who are familiar with the equivalent playing level of Division 3 and Division 4 across the Asia Pacific paintball circuit. New to SPS 2023, a maximum of 3 Open Division players can be rostered in the Amateur Division teams.

EQUIPMENT

Players will need to have their essential personal paintball equipment. SPS will not be responsible for any loss or damage of equipment during the event. All overseas markers will need to be registered with the Singapore Police Force and license for possession, importation and exportation. All license fees will be directly payable to Singapore Police Force upon their approval.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SPS 2023 will be regulated using SPS Rules and Regulations Version 2.0 (dated February 2023). Participants are reminded to read the rules and regulations of competition paintball before participation. A PDF version of the SPS Rules and Regulations will be available for download on www.singaporepaintballseries.com.

SPS 2023 will be officiated by Singapore Paintball Series Referees and AsiaRefs or any qualified bodies as determined by the organizers. Singapore Paintball Referees are required to undergo at least 15 hours of theory and practical training before any assignment.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR OVERSEAS TEAMS AND PLAYERS

From 21 September 2020, the Singapore Police Force (SPF) requires all overseas paintball markers to apply for possession, import and export licenses when used for Singapore Paintball Series.

All application will have to be completed online. However due to a migration issue on the SPF application platform, all application for Event #1 on 5 March 2023 will have to be completed via manual submission. Kindly download and fill up the application form and submit it back to info@singaporepaintballseries.com.

Cut Off Date and Time: 15 February 2023, 12PM

POSSESSION LICENCE - \$40.00 PER MARKER

IMPORT & EXPORT LICENCE - \$22.00 PER LICENCE

Example: An overseas team has intention to participate in a SPS event. The team comprises of 7 players and want to use 7 paintball markers for the event. As there are 7 markers, each marker will require a possession licence. Thus the application fee of \$280.00 (7 x \$40.00). As the team will be travelling together for the event and will arrive and depart Singapore on the same date, they will be required to apply for an import and export licence which will cost \$44.00 (2 x \$22.00). The total fees paid for licence will be \$324.00. Split over a team of 7 players, the cost per player will be about \$46.00 per player. Teams with lesser markers brought into Singapore will pay lesser application fees. All application fees are paid to SPF
